Procedure:

1. Mix components 1–3 and 2/3 of the defoamer.

2. Add the pigment and silica (for inorganic pigments) slowly, while agitating, and mix until a homogeneous liquid is obtained.
3. Grind until the desired fineness is achieved.

4. Add the remaining 1/3 of the defoamer and the biocide and mix for 10 minutes.
